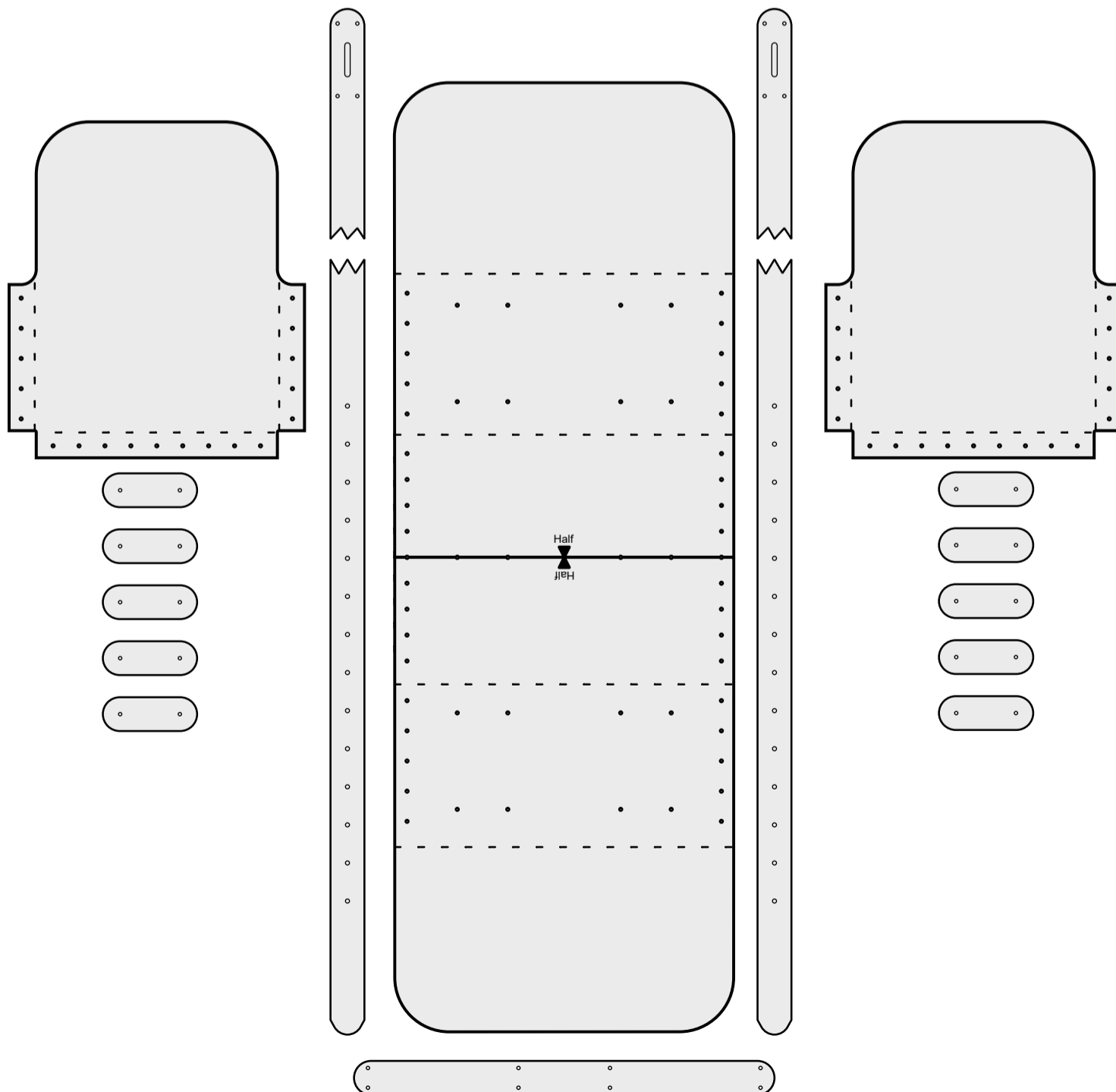
Leather Box Pattern

A bit of a history: these boxes were used in Paris Dakar rally on enduro bikes which was zooming through Sahara desert with ridiculous speed. And these boxes were used to carry necessary tools, so they had to be strong and rugged.

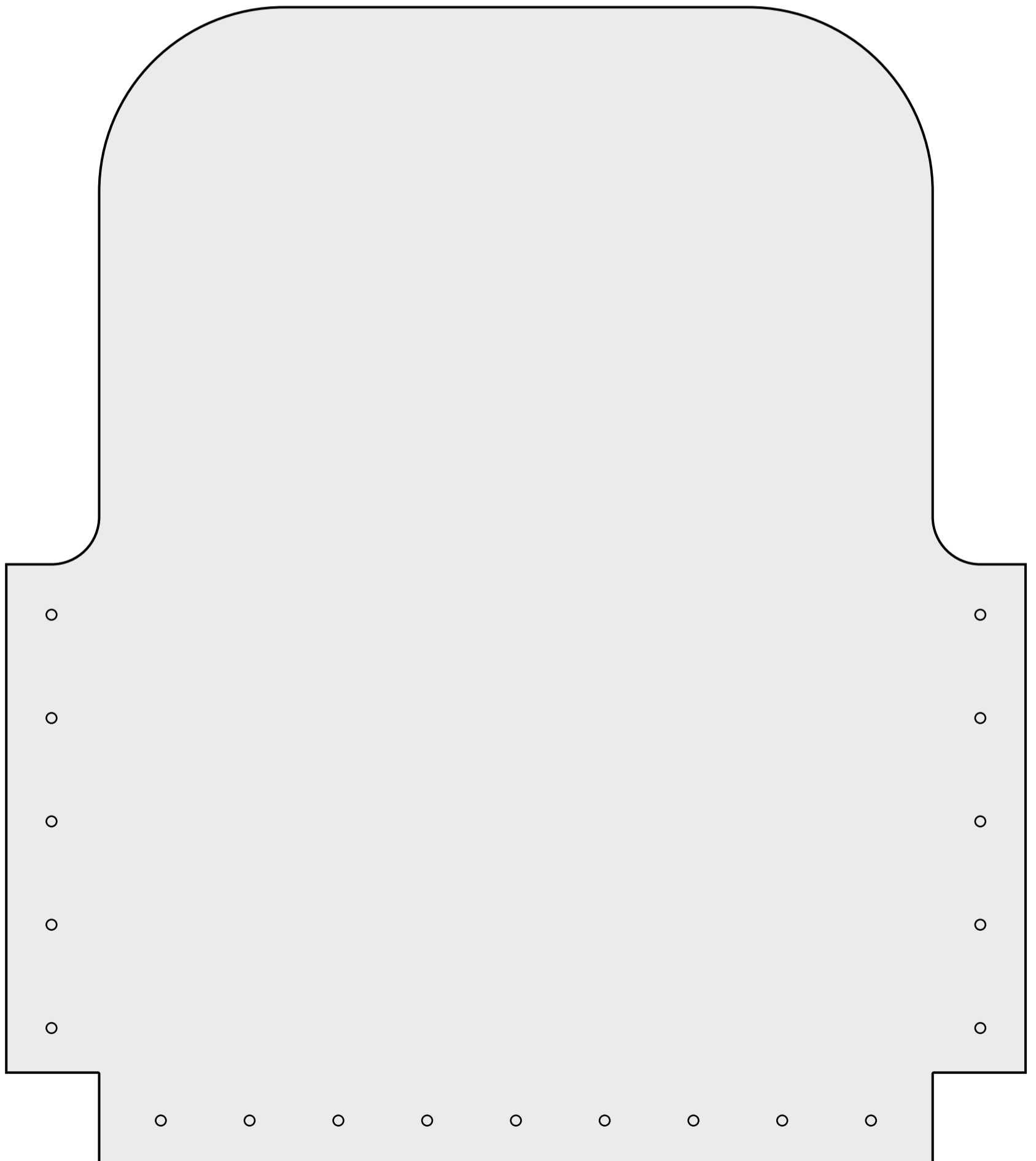
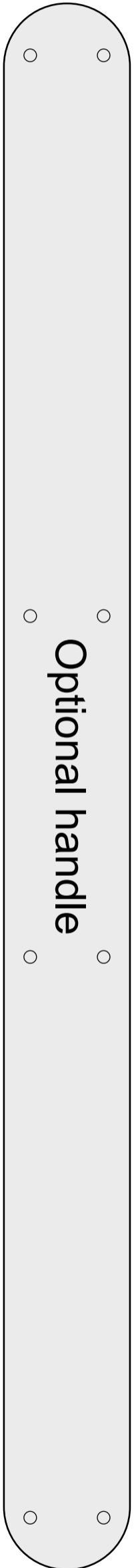
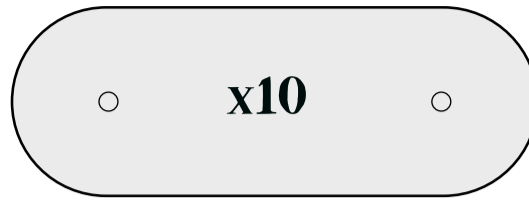
This is a bit more complex project but because there is no stitching involved so it's not so time-consuming, obviously you can modify this pattern and make it stitched up instead of riveted together just replace rivet holes with some stitching lines and then you have it. It takes about 3-4 hours to complete this project if you have pre-dyed leather. We recommend to use 3.5mm-4mm (9-10 oz) thick leather we use veg tan leather. On the bottom of this page you get all parts of leather you need to cut out for this project. The long straps have to be at least 105cm (41 inch) long 25mm wide. **This pattern is for A3 Printer**. Print page 3 once and page 4 twice

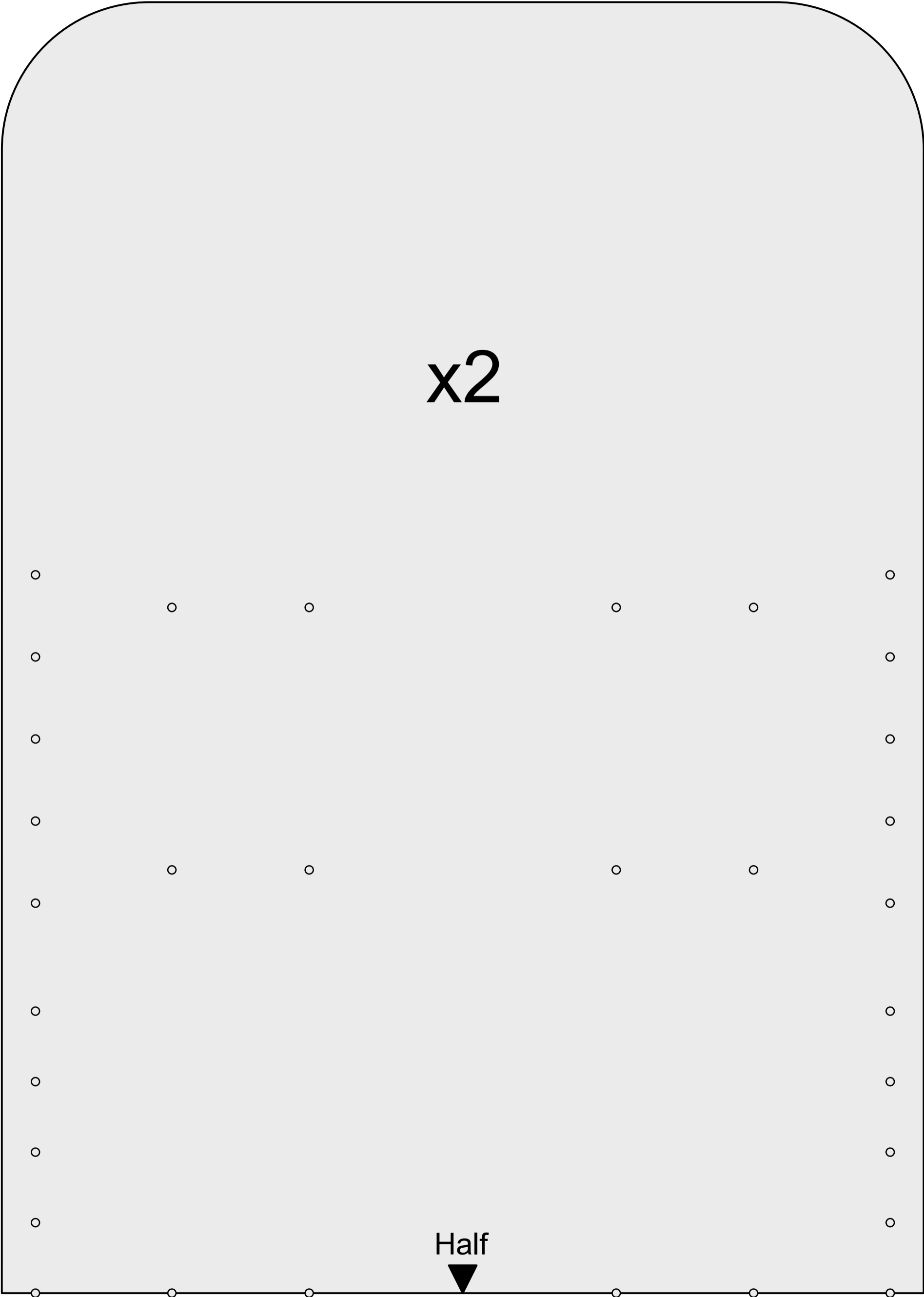
