Wet-formed Handbag

If you have patience and have enough time to do this project you can get a unique looking bag at the end.

This Handbag project is an advanced project we will mainly use wet shaping technique. It will take 2 days to make it as it involves loads of drying but it's about 4-6 working hours to finish this bag. When drying you can squeeze in a couple of other projects.

This Pattern is A3 size

Necessary tools and materials for this project:
utility knife, rotary cutter, scissors, edge creaser, hole puncher set,
ruler, stitching hole puncher prongs, needles, lighter, sandpaper, wooden form
and edge slicker

The thread we use is 0.4mm for o-rings and 0.8mm wax thread for main piece

The leather we use is veg tan cowhide 3mm-3.5mm thick
and for the o rings 2mm thick.

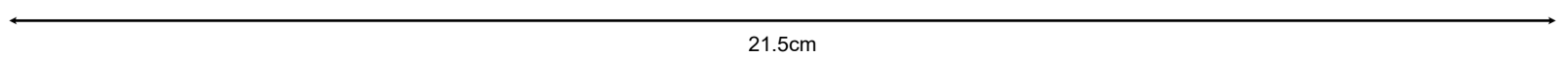
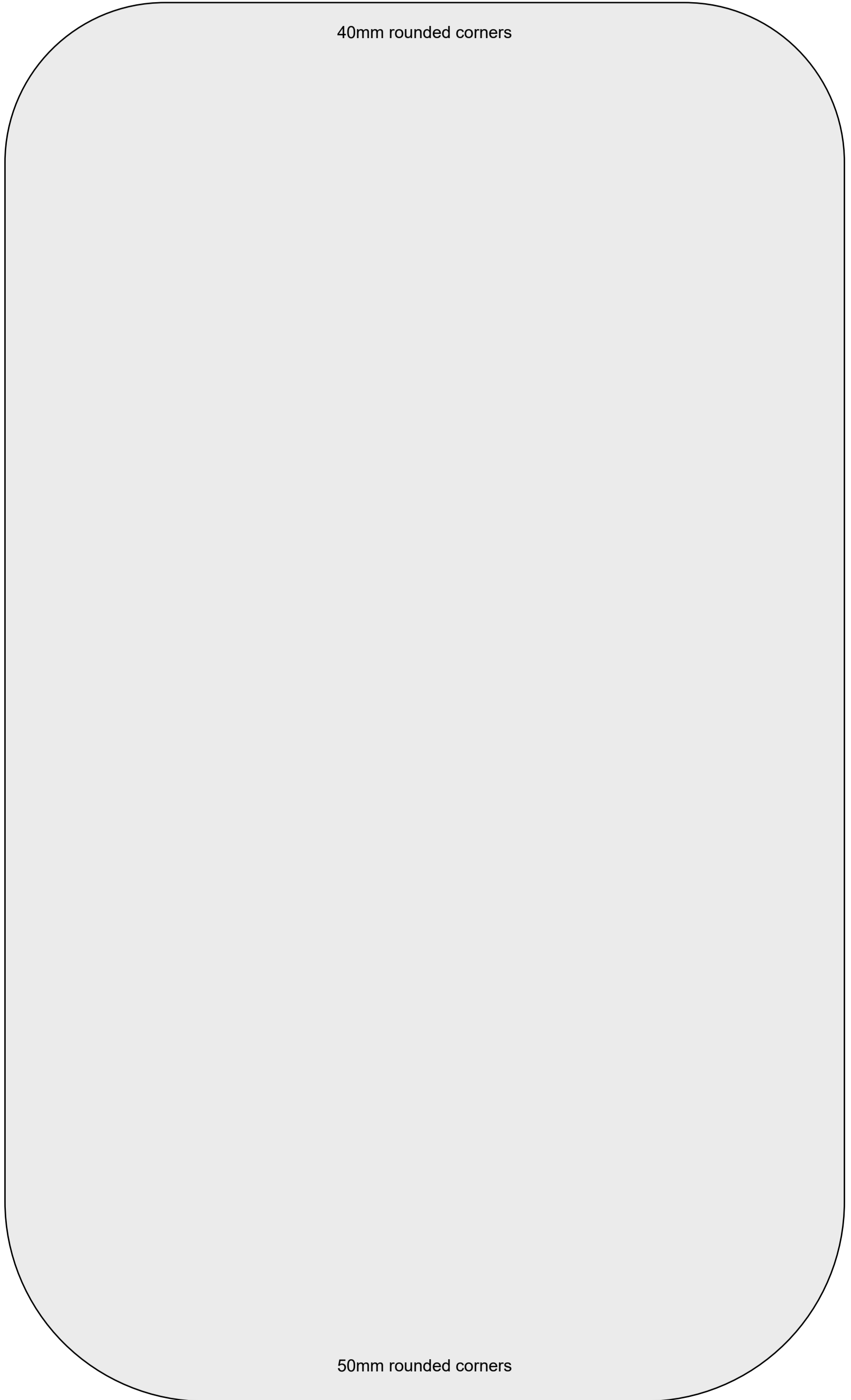
Shoulder straps 20mm/110cm long with clasp at one end,
and 20mm/40cm long with clasp at one end and buckle on the other.

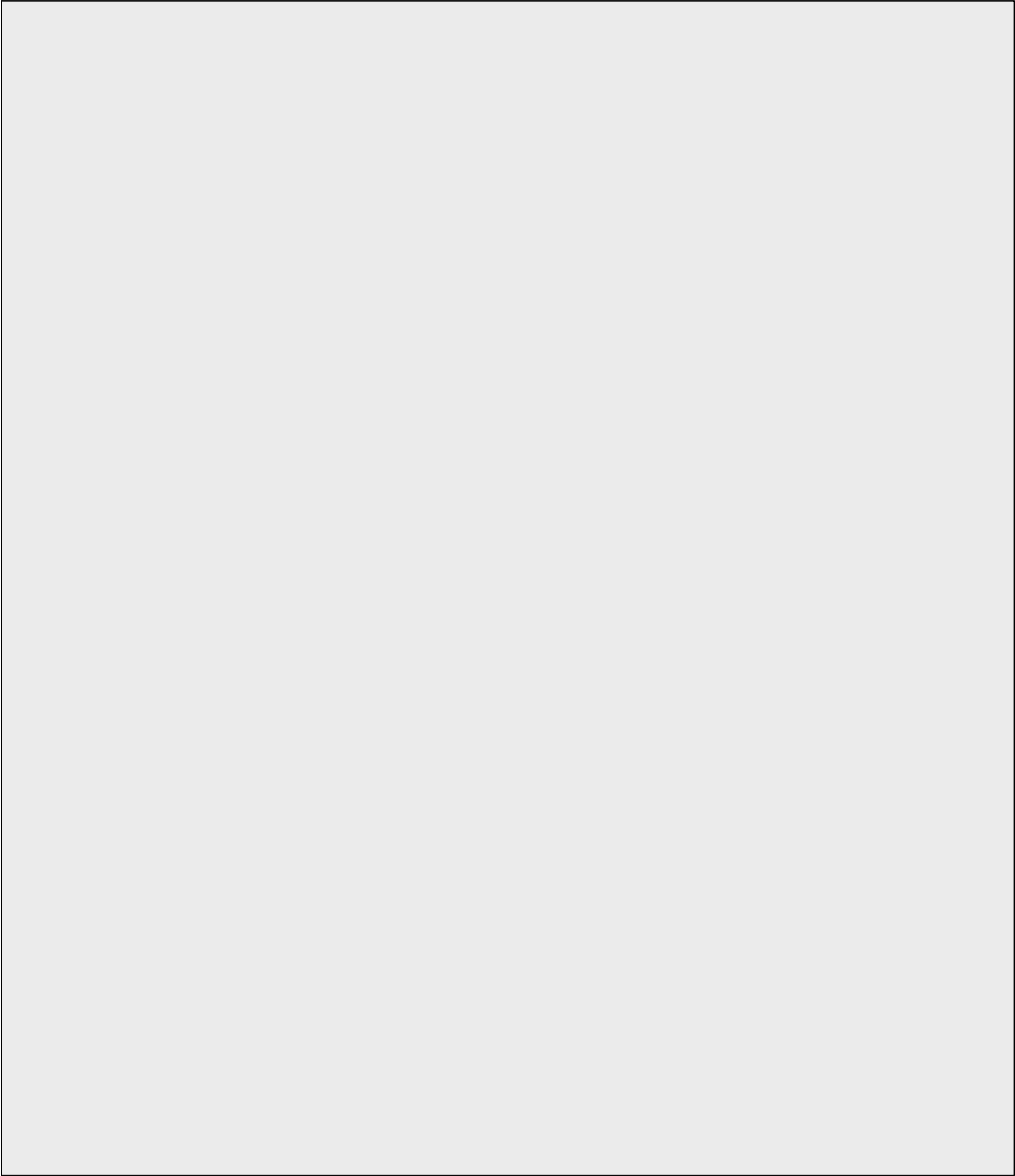
